# KENOGAMISIS GOLF CLUB NEWS

The golf season will soon be upon us as we continue to prepare the course and clubhouse for operation. While the snow is almost completely gone, work still needs to be done to get the course into playing condition. With that in mind, the Board would like to inform the membership that Jay Bailey will not be returning this year. Mike Gillis has been hired as the Superintendent, and plans are in the works to address the IPM requirement for the course as it is critical. The tentative opening for the course is scheduled to take place on Saturday May 27<sup>th</sup>. This will allow for the workers to continue working on the course over the next few days to prepare it for the new season.

The clubhouse is scheduled to be open on Thursday May 25<sup>th</sup> and Friday May 26<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., for members to come in and pay fees and bring carts/clubs to the course. Information on fees and forms was emailed to last year's members; the information is available on the home page of our website ([www.kenogamisisgolfclub.com](http://www.kenogamisisgolfclub.com)) which is back up and running! Prior to the clubhouse opening, Clubhouse workers still need to be hired, trained, and the clubhouse set up. The Kitchen (Caddy's Corner Café) opening date is still to be determined.

Golf for Gold is still tentatively scheduled for the weekend of June 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, pending condition of the course and number of teams signed up. Twenty-four (24) paid teams are required by Saturday May 27<sup>th</sup> if the tournament is to be a go. Spaces are still available, so please check out the website or the Facebook posts (or contact Al Luomala) for further details. Our new power carts are expected to arrive at the end of this week. Cart bookings for Golf for Gold (one per team) will be taken starting Thursday May 25<sup>th</sup> at 10 a.m. when the Clubhouse opens to the public.

We had a meeting with Greenstone Gold this morning and were provided with an update of the project. All is going well, the highway relocation is supposed to be finished at the end of August. Access to Mosher Lake for water for the course has been completed. NO – the course is not closing any time soon!!

A reminder that the Kenogamisis Golf Club AGM will take place on Thursday June 22<sup>nd</sup> at 8 pm in the Clubhouse. All members are encouraged to attend!!
