

JOB OPPORTUNITY - Kenogamisis Golf Club - Geraldton, ON

Assistant Course Superintendent - required asap

The Kenogamisis Golf Club is a nine hole Stanley Thompson designed course and has a history dating back to 1938.

This job is a 6 month full time position with a start date as soon as possible. The successful applicant will have the opportunity to become the Course Superintendent when the present Superintendent retires in the next 1 to 2 years.

The individual will work closely with the Course Superintendent to implement a maintenance schedule for all related equipment and turf for the golf course. The position primarily involves daytime hours Monday to Friday, however some weekend work will be required throughout the season.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Assist in the application of fertilizers and plant protection products
- 2. Mowing and horticultural duties as needed
- 3. Identifying and planning course maintenance
- 4. Take direction from the Course Superintendent in order to help supervise and train new and inexperienced staff
- 5. Assist and/or repair and maintain course irrigation system
- 6. Assist in future course planning and projects

Qualifications

- Education in Turf Management AND 1 to 3 years of experience on a golf course grounds crew is preferred OR the applicant should have 5 years experience on a golf course crew in lieu of a formal education in Turf Management
- 2. Must have a working knowledge of turf types, disease ID, horticultural procedures, IPM (Integrated Pesticide Management), and daily mowing needs
- 3. Must be physically fit and able to lift 23kg (50lbs)
- 4. Having a IPM (applicator's) license is an asset
- 5. Applicants must be willing to work towards an applicator's license in a timely fashion if currently without one
